Because of the low attendance in CCW Teams, there will be awarded Medals of the organizer in this division.

3.2. Competition Program (attached)

The latest competition program is shown at the end of this document. Any official competition schedule will have indicated the version number and the date-hour it was printed. The latest version of the Comp. Schedule is V 1.0. The last version of the scheduled used during the competition will bear the initials of the TD, make sure you have the correct schedule when the competition starts.

3.3. Practice.

Official Practice (3 hours all disciplines) Shooting in AB-CD format. In the morning session the nations from Austria to Moldova shoot (all archers)







In the afternoon the nations from Netherlands to Ukraine shoot (all archers). This is due to the transport from the hotels.

Be prepared that the archers shooting the afternoon session will be transported directly to the <u>Opening ceremony</u>, so it is recommended that the archers wear their team uniform. The equipments will be left guarded at the field. After the short Opening Ceremony all archers and officials will march back to a Meet & Greet party at the field before being transported back to the hotels. Dinner will be "Noodle Party", no drinks included. See the attached plan for the opening ceremony and back to the Meet and Greet party.

Qualification Round Practice (45minutes before the Competition) on the Field of Play.

3.4. Equipment Inspection.

Equipment inspection will be run following the program the day of the official practice. Each team will be called (following alphabetical order) and invited by the DoS to a place that will be clearly indicated in the competition field. All team members should wear their team uniform. Also all spare equipment must be brought to the equipment inspection.

The checking of passports will be already at the accreditation, so please bring the passports.

The Back Number will be given at the Accreditation to the Team captains When receiving the registration numbers, we would like each Team Captain to double check that each archer has the correct registration number and the right spelling of the athletes' name.

Registration numbers must be worn on the archers' quiver or thigh facing the waiting line. During the equipment inspection a demonstration on the usage of the scoring Terminals will be carried out. We are kindly asking all the archers and coaches to follow the OC volunteers and Judges Instructions in order to proceed with no delays and as organised as possible.

The Environment!

We kindly request you to instruct your athletes to use the litter bins which are placed in the waiting area.

Water:

To help with environmental issues we would like to enforce the water bottle deposit system. With your accreditation you receive 10 waterchips and a Masterchip. For each token you get 1 liter of water out from the water booth.

You will only receive a new token by returning one empty bottle. If your athletes loose the empty bottle, please contact the OC.

Please refer to the attached water-scheme.







It is as simple as: 1 token and the Masterchip to be delivered in the morning = 1 full bottle of water at the boot.

Return of one empty bottle = 1 new bottle

In the afternoon: One empty bottle = return of the Masterchip

If 10 liter of water is not sufficient, all archers and official will receive as much waters as needed.

Abiding by this simple rule, you actively help to run the competition smoothly and in addition help to avoid useless waste.

Non Smoking:

This is a non smoking event for the practice and official competition areas.

Inside public buildings you are now no longer allowed to smoke, you must use the designated areas outside.

3.5. Qualification Round and information on scoring

The target assignment will be handed out in the venue and the hotel the day of the official practice.

Qualification Round, on July 14th Morning session: Cadets @ 60 m. Practice from 8.00 a.m to 8.45. Qualification 2 x 36 arrows, start at 8.50 am.

4 archers per target in AB – CD format. <u>Please be ready to shoot 1/32 Elimination directly after the qualification round.</u>

Afternoon session: Juniors @ 70 m. Practice from 2.00 p.m to 2.45. Qualification 2 x 36 arrows, start at 2.50 pm.

4 archers per target in AB – CD format. <u>Please be ready to shoot 1/32 Elimination directly after the qualification round.</u>

The athletes will be given an electronic score terminal for each target, hanging behind. In addition, in the qualification round there is also one paper score sheet per target, which must be filled in by the athletes themselves. For each target one athlete will enter the score in the paper score sheet; another athlete will score on the terminal. All the athletes on the same target must verify that the correct scores are entered.

<u>Please instruct your athletes to sign the score sheets before handing them back after each round, including total score, 10's and X's,</u>

Sample of score sheets will be handed out at the Team Captains Meeting.







3.6. Individual Elimination Round & Team Elimination Round for Cadets, July 15th and Junior Mixed Teams

Individual Elimination Round, on Thursday July 15th starts at 8:15. Competition starts at 9.00 with all archers that will shoot 1/16, 1/8, 1/4, 1/2. We will respect starting time at the beginning of the session and then run the competition as it goes.

In the afternoon Teams will start practice at 14:00. Competition starts at 14:45 starting with 1/8 RCM and RCW, 1/4 and 1/2 RCM, RCW, CCM.

Please note that <u>Junior Mixed team start practice at 11:30 and competition at 12:00</u>. Mixed team competition will start at 1/4 finals and 1/2 finals, followed by the Medal matches for junior mixed teams. Medals will be awarded Saturday, July 18th

The new Set System will be used for the individual Elimination (see explanation below in point 4.3.4) Team competition will be shot without set system.

No faces will be changed as default and matches will start as soon as the field is ready.

No alternate shooting. Byes are allowed. In case of a bye, archers will be allowed to shoot in their own target, but no score will be recorded or allowed to be displayed.

3.7. Individual Elimination Round & Team Elimination Round for Juniors, Friday July 16th

Individual Elimination Round, on July 16th starts at 8:15Hr, Competition starts at 9.00Hr with all archers that will shoot 1/16, 1/8, 1/4, 1/2. We will respect starting time at the beginning of the session and then run the competition as it goes.

In the afternoon Teams will start practice at 14:00Hr, Competition starts at 14:45Hr with 1/8 RJM, RJW and CJM, 1/4 RJM and RJW, 1/4 CJM and CJW, 1/2 all archers.

Please not that <u>Cadet Mixed team start practice at 11.30 and competition at 12:00</u>. Mixed team competition will start at 1/4 finals and 1/2 finals, followed by the Medal Matches for cadet mixed teams. Medals will be awarded Saturday, July 18th

No alternate shooting. Byes are allowed. In case of a bye, Teams will be allowed to shoot on their own target, but no score will be recorded or allowed to be displayed.







3.8. Individual Finals Round & Team Finals Round, July 17th

All matches are scheduled to be shot on 4 targets at the same time. (2 matches simultaniously), Alternate Shooting.

The award ceremonies will be done according to the schedule attached. All archers involved in the ceremonies are requested to go to the gathering point in order to proceed fast and smooth with the medal ceremony. At the end of the ceremony there will be a photo of all medals winner.

3.9. Appeal Procedure (Form attached)

Appeal form is attached to this document

In case of Intent to appeal or a real Appeal, the times indicated on the Appeal form attached must be considered.

The Appeal form should be given to the Chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission or to the deputy. A deposit of Euro 50,- must be paid to the EMAU TD or the Chairperson of the Tournament Judge Commission, for the Appeal to be valid.

When the Appeal is handled positively by the Jury of Appeal, the money will be returned. In case of non-acceptance, the money is not returned.

4) Technical Matters *EMAU TD* + *chairperson of Judges*)

4.1. Timing Control system.

The "Archery Electronic" timing system will be used for qualification- & elimination rounds. "Danage" system will be used for medal matches.

4.2. Results system.

The scoring in the qualification round will be done by the archers. One archer will write down the score on the manual score sheet and another archer will score on a terminal. The other archer(s) verifies that the correct scores are entered.

During the Equipment Inspection your archers are asked to test the terminals and see if they understand the correct working of the terminals. Terminals are used during the qualification and eliminations, but not in finals. The person responsible for the results is Mr Emmilio Allmendinger.

4.3. Rules that apply in this event.

4.3.1. Phase to start the Elimination

The cut will be at 64 archers / 16 teams

4.3.2. The Rankings

According to the schedule attached, the Junior Cup results will be updated and there will be an award ceremony on Thursday and Friday.

4.3.4. Explanation of the new Rules that will be used.

What is the format of the Elimination Rounds for Individuals?

Individuals:

In Winnenden, competitors will use the Set System:

- They shoot sets (previously ends) for a maximum of three (3) sets of six (6) arrows at a regular target from the 1/32 round to the quarterfinals.
- > Once the athletes reach the quarterfinals, they will shoot a maximum of five (5) sets of three (3) arrows.
- Moreover, in the medal matches, the athletes alternate shooting one arrow at a time with a 20-second time limit between arrows.
- ➤ The target is set to the distance of 70M for Juniors and 60M for Cadets.

What is the Set System?

Here are the principles of the Set System for the matches until the quarterfinals:

- All matches leading into the quarterfinals consist of a maximum of 3 sets of 6 arrows per set.
- The winner of each set, the athlete who gets the highest cumulative score with his six arrows, gets two (2) set points.
- If the set is tied each athlete gets 1 set point.
- > The winner of the match is determined by the number of set points won, not the value of the arrows.
- > The match winner is the first to reach 4 set points.
- The match will finish once the 4 set points is reached within the 3 sets.
- ➤ If the match is tied; a one-arrow (only!) shoot-off will be used to break the tie. The archer whose arrow is closest to the centre (if needed it will be measured) will get 1 extra point and wins.
- ➤ The athletes shoot simultaneously their arrows and have four (4) minutes to shoot 6 arrows.

So let's see some examples of World Cup matches (for 1/32, 1/16 and 1/8):

Match Z:

First set:

Athlete A shoots: 10, 10, 9, 10, 7, 10 = 56

Athlete B shoots: 10, 9, 9, 9, 7, 9 = 53 Athlete A leads 2 set points to 0.

Second set:

Athlete A shoots: 10, 10, 10, 10, 7, 10 = 57 Athlete B shoots: 10, 9, 8, 8, 7, 9 = 51

Athlete A leads 4-0 and wins! The match is over, because archer B cannot

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catch up with the score.

On the match chart results, the score will be shown as:

Athlete A : 4 (56, 57) Athlete B : 0 (53, 51)

Match Y:

First set:

Athlete C shoots: 10, 10, 9, 10, 7, 10 = 56

Second set:

Athlete C shoots: 10, 10, 10, 10, 7, 10 = 57

Athlete D shoots: 10, 9, 8, 8, 7, 9 = 51 Athlete C leads 3-1.

Third set:

Athlete C shoots: 10, 10, 8, 8, 8, 10 = 54 points Athlete D shoots: 10, 10, 10, 10, 7, 8 = 55 points

Athlete D tied the match at 3-3. A one-arrow shoot-off is required to break the

tie (and give 1 extra set point).

Shoot-off: Athlete C shoots: 10 Athlete D shoots: 10*

Let's assume that the arrow of the athlete D is the closest to centre and wins!

On the match chart results, the score will be shown as:

Athlete C: 3 (56, 57, 54; T10) Athlete D: 4 (56, 51, 55; T10*)

*Closest to centre

For quarterfinals through medal matches, the principles are:

- The match changes to a maximum 5 sets of 3 arrows per set.
 - The match winner this time is the first to achieve 6 points.
 - If the match is tied, a one-arrow shoot-off will be used to break the tie. In the tie-break, the archer whose arrow is closest to the centre (if needed it will be measured) will get 1 extra point and wins.
 - For quarterfinals and semifinals, the athletes shoot simultaneously their arrows and have 2 minutes to shoot 3 arrows.
 - For medal matches, the athletes will shoot alternately each arrow and will have 20 seconds per arrow. In alternate shooting, the athletes trailing in the score shoot first.

So let's see some other examples of matches (for 1/4, 1/2, bronze medal, gold medal)

Match X:

First set:

Athlete A shoots: 10, 10, 9 = 29

Athlete B shoots: 10, 9, 9 = 28 Athlete A leads 2 set points to 0.

Second set:

Athlete A shoots: 10, 10, 10 = 30

Athlete B shoots: 10, 9, 8 = 27 Athlete A leads 4-0.







Third set:

Athlete A shoots: 10, 9, 9 = 28Athlete B shoots: 10, 9, 8 = 27

Athlete A leads 6-0 and wins! The match is over, because archer B cannot catch up

with the score.

Match W:

First set:

Athlete C shoots: 10, 10, 9 = 29

Athlete D shoots: 10, 9, 10 = 29 The score is tied at 1-1

.

Second set:

Athlete C shoots: 10, 10, 10 = 30

Athlete D shoots: 10, 5, 7 = 22 Athlete C leads 3-1.

Third set:

Athlete C shoots: 10, 10, 8, = 28

Athlete D shoots: 10, 10, 10 = 30 Athlete D ties the match at 3-3.

Fourth set:

Athlete C shoots: 10, 9, 8, = 27

Athlete D shoots: 10, 10, 10 = 30 Athlete D takes the lead 5-3!

Fifth set:

Athlete C shoots: 10, 10, 9, = 29 Athlete D shoots: 10, 10, 8 = 28

Athlete C earns the two points and ties the match at 5-5! One arrow shoot-off is

required to break the tie (to earn the extra set point).

Shoot-off:

Athlete C shoots: 10

Athlete D shoots: 9 Athlete C wins! On the match chart results, the score will be shown as:

Athlete A : 6 (29, 30, 28) Athlete B : 0 (28, 27, 27)

Athlete C: 5 (29, 30, 28, 27, 29; T10) Athlete D: 6 (29, 22, 30, 30, 28; T9)

What about the (regular) Team and Mixed Team Round?

Team:

In the regular team and mixed team round (that will be shot in Winnenden), the matches go as follows:

- Each team shoots a total of 4 ends of 6 arrows, with the three team members shooting 2 arrows each per end.
- > Each team will have 2 minutes to complete each end.
- > The total of all 24 arrows will be added to determine a total score (max score 240).







Mixed Team:

- > The competition has the same principles as for teams, however there are only two athletes competing one woman and one man per country.
- > They shoot a total of 4 ends, with each team member shooting 2 arrows per end for a total of 16 arrows (max score 160).
- Each team has 80 seconds to shoot.
- > Same principle also applies as for team for alternating and order of shooting.

To note, the mixed teams are ranked based on the results from the top ranked man and the top ranked woman from the same Member Association. However, the Member Association can choose the man and the woman (among the whole team) who will shoot the matches.

In case of ties:

- Each archer from each team will shoot one arrow.
- > The total for that end (3 arrows for team and 2 arrows for mixed team) will be calculated and the winner is the team with the highest point score.
- In the event of another tie, a second end will be shot.
- In the event of a third tie, the team with the closest arrow to the centre will win the match.

- 4.3.6. Dress Instructions

Athletes, officials and staff should have a proper appearance, when they are present on the field. Athletes and Technicians should wear no other kind of foot wear, other than sport shoes.

- 4.3.7. Correct height of scope

As in 2009 season, FITA and EMAU are again reinforcing this season the rule of the scopes height. The final goal is to prevent images (TV & photos) of the "scope" covering the archer face.

The height is determined by the highest point of the scope not the height of the lens. The maximum is the lowest part of the armpit. The reason we are asking is not to block the view of cameras of the archer's face. If we continue to have issues, we will instruct the judges to remove the scopes until the end of the match.







5) Logistical Aspects (OC)

5.1. Transportation:

Check the schedule in the hotels and at the competition field for daily transport between the hotels and the competition area and return.

5.2. Meals, during competition

Meals will be served at the field when booked by the Organizers in advance. There will be some extra food available at the field.

...5. 3 Other Social Aspects

There will be a <u>special invitation to the Team Captains</u> on Thursday, July 15th at 19.30 by the Mayor of Winnenden in the Town Hall. A special invitation for one Team Member will be handed out, transport will be provided.

6. Protocol and ceremonies

6.1. Opening Ceremony

There is an Opening Ceremony planned. All archers that shot the morning session will be picked up at their hotels. The archers shooting the afternoon session will be picked up at the field at 16.45 and brought to the meeting point downtown. Bow cases will be kept secured at the field.

All archers and officials will be brought back to the field for at meal at the Meet & Greet party.

6.2. Closing Ceremony

There will be a short closing ceremony on the field, following the medals ceremony in the Saturday afternoon. No bows and flags will be allowed on the podium.

6.3Closing Party

Pick up from official hotels at 19.15 to the venue. After dinner, disco in the same room. First bus returns at 22.00

7. Medical Related issues

Ambulance and First Aid Services will be available in the archery venue.

In case of emergency during you stay in the hotel, please inform the reception and proper arrangements will be made. Please inform the competition management on any issue. Please refer also to the list of Hospitals above.







8. Doping Control

8.1 Doping control

Doping control will follow FITA rules.

Your athletes should bring their passports or accreditation cards to the doping control when they will be chosen for a test.

8.2. Alcohol test

Level of alcohol might be also being tested during the competition, following FITA rules.

9. Other matters of importance EMAU TD

Accreditation cards:

The accreditation card must be worn at all times in the practice and competition areas. Only athletes competing in certain stages of the event are allowed on the Field of play, together with their coaches. Your cooperation in ensuring only the correct athletes are on the Field of Play would be appreciated as it'll make a better event for all.

One coach per archer!!!

Internet access:

In hotels wireless internet is available but it is not a free service. Please check with the reception in your hotel how to get this access and its cost.

On the field please refer to a special note in the post boxes concerning the website for results.






